

ORDER

AND NOW, this 10th day of December, 2010, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission having filed the above-referenced Petition for a Waiver of the Intrastate Motor Carrier Safety Regulations for its trucks and implements of husbandry, it is hereby ordered, pursuant to 1 Pa. Code § 35.18, that the Petition for a Waiver is granted and that the commercial motor vehicle marking requirements in 49 CFR § 390.21, as adopted in 67 Pa. Code Chapter 231 (relating to intrastate motor carrier safety) are waived for (1) farm vehicles and implements of husbandry transporting agricultural products or farm supplies other than hazardous materials of a type and quantity that require the vehicle to be placarded, and (2) vehicles of state and local governments and agencies of state and local governments.


