Connecting with our Ag Community

Sandy Craft and her husband Bob have embraced the Mercer County agricultural community. They are enjoying life in their rural home and have become involved in the organizations that are important to Mercer County agriculture.

"I was surprised that there was no FFA in Mercer County," Sandy said. "Not one school had an ag program."

As she began to talk to folks she learned that one by one the ag programs were closed.

"Agriculture is the number one industry in our state and we have no presence in our school curriculum!"

Being new to the area, she didn't know whom she should or shouldn't talk to so she just started to visit with people.

She found an ally in Jay Russell, director of the county conservation district, who is also new to the area. Together they began doing some research that, most recently, resulted in a meeting at the Mercer County Career Center with the superintendents of schools from across the county.

Part of the presentation that Sandy made at that meeting will be shown at the spring dinner meeting.

Kelsey Stewart, state FFA chaplain, from Franklin County and retired Mohawk ag teacher, Cliff Wallace, shared with the superintendents how FFA and ag education isn't just about preparing students to become production farmers.

If you are a school board member or know a school board member in your school district, please have a conversation about the need for an agricultural program at the Mercer County Career Center and the benefits of including FFA there for the students.

It will be interesting to follow the progress of this project.

Bob and Sandy Craft, Sam Huff and Andrew Spencer attended the American Farm Bureau Federation Convention in Nashville in January.


"President Trump and Reba on the same day!," Sam said as he reflected on the annual meeting for Farm Bureau members from across the nation.

Please contact any board member with the name and contact information of a teacher who may be interested. If you would like brochures to give to teachers let the board know.







